Ongoing War

5th June, 2011 marked the completion of three decades of identification of first case of HIV/AIDS. Then, no one had imagined the degree to which the infection would spread in such a short span, Presently more than 33.4 million individuals survive with this disease which WAS considered to have no treatment. Recently there was a buzz in the Medical Community when Mr. Timothy Brown, presently 45, diagnosed HIV positive in 1995, had been declared completely 'FREE' from the disease. He is famous among the medical circles as "THE BERLIN PATIENT"

In 2006, he was on anti retroviral therapy when he was diagnosed for Acute Myeloid Leukaemia (FAB M4 subtype). He was treated with two rounds of induction chemotherapy after which he developed renal failure. HAART was discontinued for a while, which resulted in HIV viral rebound (diagnosed by serial PCR for viral counts). Seven months after the initial diagnosis, his AML relapsed. Allogenic stem cell transplantation was done. Out of the 80 HLA matching subjects, 64 underwent acreening for the OCR5 mutation and only one matching donor was found. Post transplantation, he was negative for HIV, HAART was stopped and be is still HIV penative with 3.5 years of follow up.

The trick in this case was the deliberate selection of the homozygous CCR5 mutant by oncologist Gero Huetter and his colleagues at Berlin's University Hospital who treated Timothy. To enter target cells, HIV-1 requires both CD4 and a co-receptor, predominantly CCR5. Blocking of the preferentially used CCR5 receptor by inhibitors or through gene knockdown, will bring antiviral protection. The homozygous CCR5 delta32 deletion. observed in approximately 1% of the white population, offers a natural resistance to HIV

Past attempts to graft "immune" T-cells failed, due to the long lifespan of the victim's infected T-cells. Long lifespan bought the virus enough time to mutate and overcome the graft's immunity. But in Mr. Brown's case, the chemotherapy killed enough of the infected cells that the mutation was not able to occur (in HIV, to overcome the newly acquired immunity). CCR5 delta32 is associated with high but not complete resistance to HIV-1. Mr. Brown was fortunate in that a donor was found who happened to have this mutation. Most won't be that lucky. But researchers are hoping to create stem cells from the natient's various cell lines, differentiate them into T-cells, and finally using gene therapy to knock

Certainly, the treatment Brown received could not be applied to the millions of people infected with HIV - it is far too risky and expensive for that. But its results offer proof that there are ways to turbo-charge the immune system to prevent and even fight off established infection without taking a cocktail of pills every day, the officials wrote in the Annals of Internal Medicine.

This treatment may not be viable to extend to the common man but this case was the breakthrough of 30 years of tireless research in the field of HIV treatment which seemed fruitless till date.

This case brings hope to the medical fratemity: What mankind has achieved in case of Tuberculosis, Plague and countless other disease CAN BE REPEATED with HIV. Novel describes intolerable pressures on medical students & doctors but this 'Men of God' as often quoted by people; handle this cruelty & serve the mankind smiling. But paradoxically, doctors are treated with sarcasm & disgust by some people We all know that these immortal acts & malpractice are sins of minority. As a matter of fact, Medical profession contains far more saints than sin-

The novel also illustrates most troublesome time for docs... It is when he knows the diagnosis but can't treat the patient. It is the time when patient (& a doctor too) surrenders to god & you despite being physician can't do anything but to stand beside your patient speechless helpless

The maladaptive lifestyle of doctors is also aptly written, "WHY DOCS FAIL TO CARE FOR THEMSELVES?" There is no suitable answer for this but this is no more than one of the painful realities of life in an unbelievably demanding profession. So sometimes doctors are called as "WOUNDED HEALERS" or "THE IMPAIRED PHYSICIANS"
