R2020 became one of the most awaited books in Indian history. More than half a million preorders proclaim its evidence.

Book revolves around the life of three childhood friends: Gopal, an ambitious person and narrator; Aarti, a beautiful girl; and Raghav, a passionate writer. Gopal struggles in his life to reach his ambition and at last chooses the path of corruption. Raghav wants to remove every unjust thing from society and change the system by his revolutionary thoughts. Aarti's character emerges as a confused girl about her love life.

Some part of this triangular love story is an amalgam of movies "Sangam" and "Hazaar khwaishain aisi". The book is simply but stunningly written. After pulling us into its own world from the start; the story never loses its stream. The writer marks an impression on reader's mind on the point of current competitive exams, corrupted education system and revolution. With maintaining his narrative style same as his previous books, he adds a few ornaments of description about Varanasi.
