"Seek And Ye Shall Find." With these words echoing in his mind. Robert Langdon, famous Harvard symbolist wakes up in a baspital bed having no idea of where he is or how he got there. He also finds in his jacket a macabre object, its origin unknown. Inferno means 'Hell' in Italian. It is the first part of the spite poom. The Divine Comedy 'written by Italian peet Dante, describing Dante's journey through hell. One of the major problems the world faces as of today is exponential population growth. Earth's ecosystem can sustain only 4 billion people, while the current population is nearing double this number. An eccentric blochmost and a fan of Dante's work, Bertrand Zohrist believes the WHO is not doing enough to tackle this major problem, and decides to take the matter in his own hands. He has created a device to counter the problem, which he believes is a gift of salyation for mankind. But is his solution rational? One can scarcely argue over that. He also leaves behind a clue referring to Dante's Inferno. Langdon must solve this if he wants answers to this puzzle which may or may not, help save the world from this terrifying threat.

Inferno is written in Dan Brown's classic 'race against time format' and is set in 3 beautiful cities of Europe ' Florence, Venice and Istanbul, History and art enthusiasts will love this book, for Dan Brown has written the book in great depth. Another bey named Vikram fell down his bike & immediately consulted a doctor. After seeing all the reports & X-rays, orthopsedician diagnosed arthrosis around his right knee & gare pain killer. The swelling around knee increased day by day. So he sapirated José blood from his point hut still again swelling appeared, So he consulted another orthopsedic & he was told that there had been no need of aspiration, It had to be done on the last stage. The doctor tied only pressure bandage & advised him to perform simple knee exercise, after that his condition improved.

Another girl, named Mona had accidently severe musal bleeding from her nostrils which didn't stop even for few seconds & consulted an ENT specialist. He said his nasal septum is deviated and told her that she had to be operated for that. As seen normally she became scared after hearing the name of operation. So she consulted another ENT specialist conjuy to find out that she was having only a simple nasal ulere, no need of worry. He gave her outment & nasal drops, her condition improved within 2 days. These are only a few examples. We can find many cases of misdiagnesis.

So are the doctors not doing their job properby? While we are at it, we should think about it and realize that once we reach such a post that even a simple missunderstanding on our part can put the patient's life in danger. They give us the place of God in their hearts. So, we should justify them beliefs by diagnosing & treating them properly, because they think that doctors are ALMIGHTY & we have to justify that.
