Timeless Classic III. Set in the 1770s and 80s, the plot integrates one of the most important revolutions the world has ever seen—The French Revolution with the story of Charles Darnay, Sydney Carton, Lucie Manette and the ensuing chaos. Dickens portrays a wivid picture of the tension in France and the events leading up to the overthrowing of the French Aristocracy and reclamation of the country. The plot thickens and so does the reader's interest. There is never a moment tacking in interest, be it the description of the internal turnoil Dr Manette undergoes while wrongly imprisoned or the storming of the Bastille prison. It is an excellent example of the sacrifices that a man can make for love, and the last few pages of the novel has so much of emotion that the reader feels compelled to applicable the master writing skills of Charles Dickens. He actually makes you feel sorry for the French aristocrats and their children who are condemned to the Guillottne for decades of alractices. Dickens has referred to good and exil by using metaphors of light and darkness, as is the case with most novels. He has made an excellent use of "water" in its various forms to depict the emotions of the characters; for example. The sea did what it like, and what it like dwas destruction." The "sea" here being the angry peasant mob which was about to storm the Bastille proson and free the prisoners. Overall, the book is excellently-written, well-excuted and once you read it, you are never going to forget this one for your life. Highly recommended.
