Miracle- A True Story (By Khushboo Mathuria - 2nd / 1st )

They say miracles are rare. However, what is a miracle? A pure coincidence? Or the right decision at the right time? Bearing these questions in mind, let's talk about a 2 month old boy named Sam Zarpas from Pittsburgh. This little guy faced the crisis of his life which, unfortunately, hadn't even started.

Sam was diagnosed with Idiopathic Thrombocytopenic Purpura. As per standard treatment, he was treated with steroids, though the medication often impacts growth in children. The treatment worked initially, but few months later Sam's eyes turned yellow. Doctors suspected autoimmune hepatitis and prescribed more steroids but this time, there was no improvement. His parents were frustrated and scared. However, Sam's mother had a friend at Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh UPMC and Sam's liver biopsy was sent there. The results caught eye of Director of Pediatric Hepatology, Dr Benjamin Shneider. "ITP at 2 months and liver disease at 7 months is very rare,' Dr Shneider said. He came to a conclusion of liver transplant for Sam but believed that the major

surgery would only prove to be a temporary solution. Keeping Sam's depleting health condition in mind and with an aim of the child's long term wellbeing; Dr Shneider went for a thorough diagnosis of the unheard combination of two diseases. While examining Sam's liver cells, Dr Shneider concluded a rare Giant

Cell Hepatitis and Coombs' Positive Hemolytic Anemia, in which antibodies destroy own blood cells. "But in Sam's case, antibodies were destroying his platelets,' explained Dr Shneider. "Usually Coombs' is a subset of Giant Cell Hepatitis but instead of Coombs', Sam had ITP." Eventually, Sam was treated with four weekly doses of Rituximab, a standard drug used for overactive immune system. Within 3 months, his clotting factors and liver enzymes were about normal. The steroids were reduced to minimum and Sam had started feeling better. Cindi, Sam's mother, said, 'He's 3 now and you'd never know he was sick a day in his life." She also appreciated Dr Shneider's skills, "He had a wonderful demeanor and confidence, and he kept us calm. God bless him!"

Sam is 3 now and is living an amazing life. Dr Benjamin Shneider was just the miracle Sam needed. So, think about it. Miracles are as possible as we make them.




