General Instructions for Post Graduate (MD/MS) Admissions 2023-24

1. Cautions money deposit (Rs. 84,000/- 1 month stipend) & first year government fees (Rs. 30,000) to be submitted at the time of admission:

Through Cash or Demand Draft

1. **For All India quota** - in favour of Dean, B. J. Medical College, Ahmedabad at Account section , B. J. Medical College, Ahmedabad.
2. **For State quota**- to ACPPGMEC at the time of admission

- ❖ All students have to submit receipts of the same at the time of joining the college.
- ❖ The deposit is refundable at the end of three years of residency.
- ❖ If student leaves the course midway after the admission has been confirmed, all the fees and caution money deposit will be forfeited.

The candidates have to submit a separate Demand Draft of University fees (as mentioned in the above table), to be made in the favour of “**Registrar, Gujarat University**” payable at Ahmedabad at the time of P.G. teacher allotment. PG Teacher Allotment date will be declared later on the website.

3. Bond Details:

Bond of Rs. 40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Lakhs) is applicable to the students admitted under both All India Quota (vide the Circular No: MCG/Bond/Policy/AIQ/I/28100-11/2022 dated 14/09/2022, annexed herewith) and State Quota (vide the G.R. No: MCG/1019/1643/J dated 30/01/2020, annexed herewith)

No bond is applicable to the students admitted in Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Community Medicine, Forensic Medicine and Pharmacology vide the G.R. No: MCG/1013/SFS-54/J dated 13/10/2014.

All the students must submit bond papers within 1 month of last round of admission.

After the completion of residency students either have to serve rural areas in the state of Gujarat for one year or pay the bond amount 40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Lakhs).

If the candidate leaves the course before the completion, he/she will be liable to pay bond penalty (50% of the bond amount) vide G.R. No: BND/1095/2066/J dated 08/11/1996 and penalty as per Gujarat University rules i.e Rs.5 lacs (for clinical subjects – degree), Rs.1 lac (for non clinical subjects-Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Microbiology, Forensic Medicine, PSM) as a penalty to the Gujarat University.

Bond policy modifications will be applicable to this batch as and when issued by Government of Gujarat.

4. The academic term will start from 5th September, 2023 as per NMC. The students can join the department only on/after the term start date as per the counseling schedule declared by NMC/MCC. They will be paid stipend from the term start date after their joining. Academic term will be granted by Gujarat University according to NMC rules.

5. PG teachers will be allotted to the admitted P.G. students at B. J. Medical College and affiliated hospitals/institutes as per their All India Rank.
